- 9 miles by 6 miles (just over 78km²)
- Population circa 60,000
- 30 sites throughout the island covering health and social care
- Healthcare Outpatients 2013 – 120,645
- Healthcare Inpatients 2013 – 19,818
- Accident and Emergency attendances 2013 – 17,088
- Alderney Emergency Care 2013 – 660
- Physical beds June 2014 – 332

2006	Billet submitted to replace existing PAS with Electronic Health and Social Care Record
2007	Contract signature with TrakHealth PLC
2008	TrakHealth takeover by Intersystems Go-live Phase: 1 hardware
2009	Go-Live Phase 2 Knock on effect from initial hardware delay
2010	Radiology results in EPR
2011	Mental Health Radiology Ordering
2012	Pathology ordering and results
